Why did a quarter of senior global business leaders not respond quickly enough to the pandemic? Is having an appetite for risk the defence against a crisis and should you be overhauling how you manage business risk? For instance, the SFC has issued the consultation conclusion on “The Management and Disclosure of Climate-related Risks by Fund Managers” in August 2021 where the requirements are prepared with reference to the TCFD Recommendations.
